



New Vistas is happy to announce we have been allocated CARE's Act funding to help support our community members with disabilities who have been impacted by COVID-19.

These CARES Act funds are intended to assist with the surge of needs of individuals with disabilities to access or reconnect with the services and supports they need to remain safely in their communities.

These supplemental funds are part of a one-time appropriation from Congress to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic. Fund may be used to support individuals with disabilities who are experiencing:

- Food insecurity due to loss of income and/or supports due to COVID-19.
- Housing insecurity due to impacts of COVID-19
- Reductions in access to medical and community supports due to COVID-19 and related restrictions

To apply for support, applicants must be able to meet the following minimum qualifications:

- Applicant must have a disability
- Applicant must live in New Vistas service area, which includes Santa Fe, San Miguel, **Los Alamos**, Rio Arriba, Taos, Mora, Colfax, Harding and Union counties
- Applicant requests must be directly tied to the impact of COVID-19
