**Statement from Secretary of State Maggie Toulouse Oliver on Senate Passage
of Intimate Partner Violence Survivor Suffrage Act**

SANTA FE – Secretary of State Maggie Toulouse Oliver released the following statement today after the New Mexico State Senate unanimously passed Senate Bill 190, the Intimate Partner Violence Survivor Suffrage Act:

“Victims of domestic violence should never be intimidated out of voting because they fear their personal information will become available for their abusers to find,” said Secretary of State Maggie Toulouse Oliver. “The Intimate Partner Violence Survivor Suffrage Act provides a vital protection for these victims by ensuring that they are able to vote while preventing their personal information from being accessed by their abusers. I thank Senator Daniel Ivey-Soto for working closely with my office on this piece of legislation.”
