**TOMORROW: SOS Toulouse Oliver to Host Public Hearing on Proposed Changes to Two Administrative Rules**

SANTA FE – New Mexico Secretary of State Maggie Toulouse Oliver will host a public hearing on proposed changes to two administrative rules tomorrow, August 10, 2018. The hearing will be held at 9 a.m. in Room 322 of the State Capitol Building, 490 Old Santa Fe Trail, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501.

One proposal would change an existing rule regarding the order in which political parties appear on General Election ballots to ensure that the political party order is always established before the ballots are sent to the state’s printer. The other proposal would repeal an outdated emergency voting rule for ill voters that was rendered obsolete in 2017 because of new legislation signed into law.
