- Personal Items

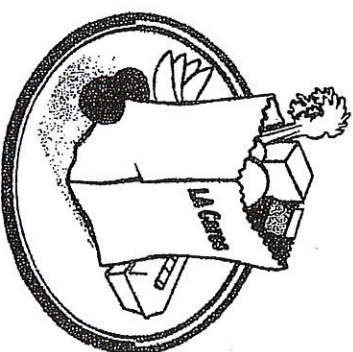
LA Cares food distribution is on the second Friday of every month, and the Thursday evening before, at Bethlehem Lutheran Church, 2390 North Road.
