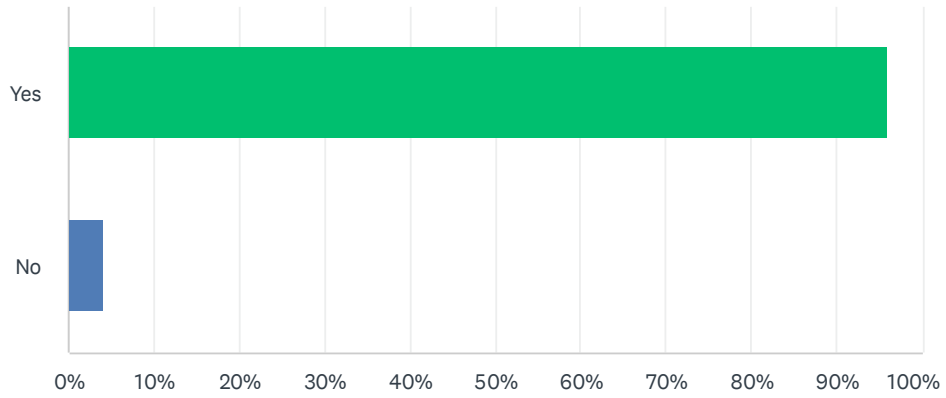


# Q1 Since 2019, have you attended a Los Alamos Summer Concert?

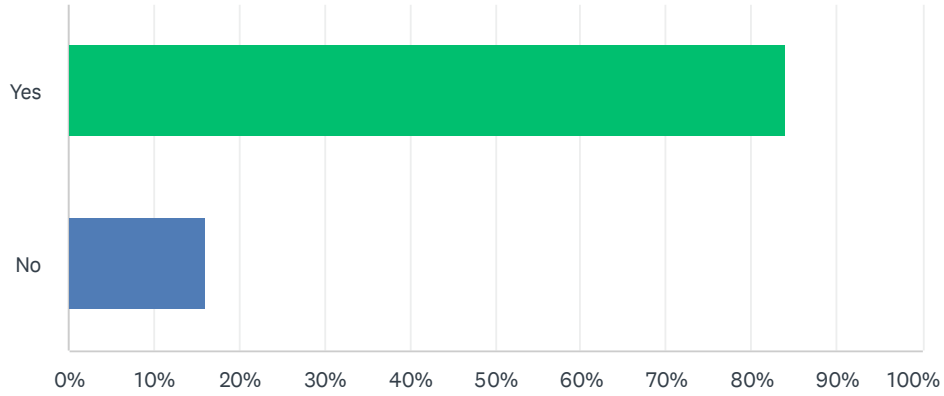

## Q2 Since 2019, Have you enjoyed attending the Los Alamos Summer Concerts?

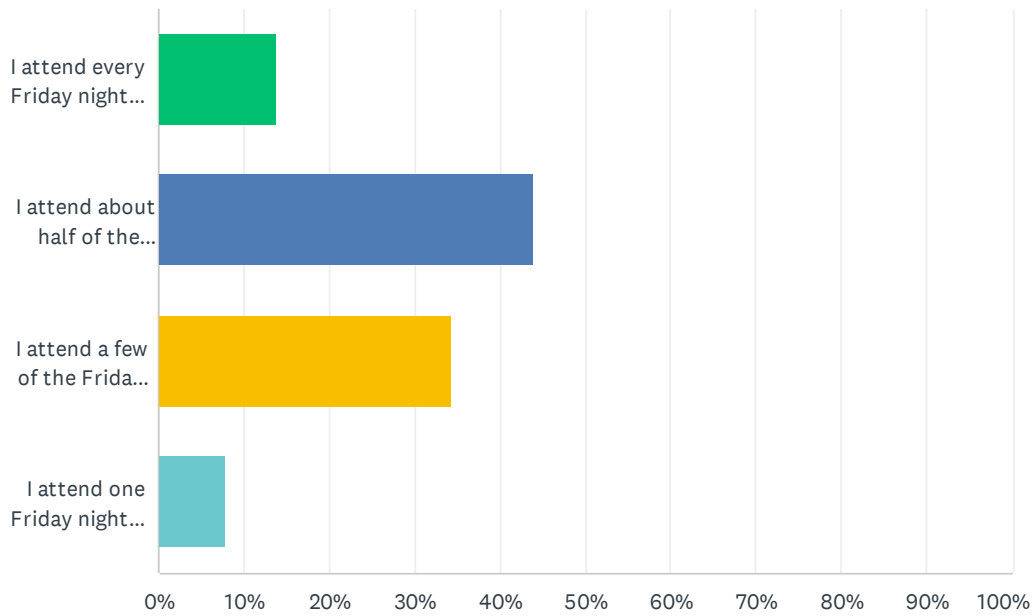

### Q3 How often do you attend the Los Alamos Summer Concerts?

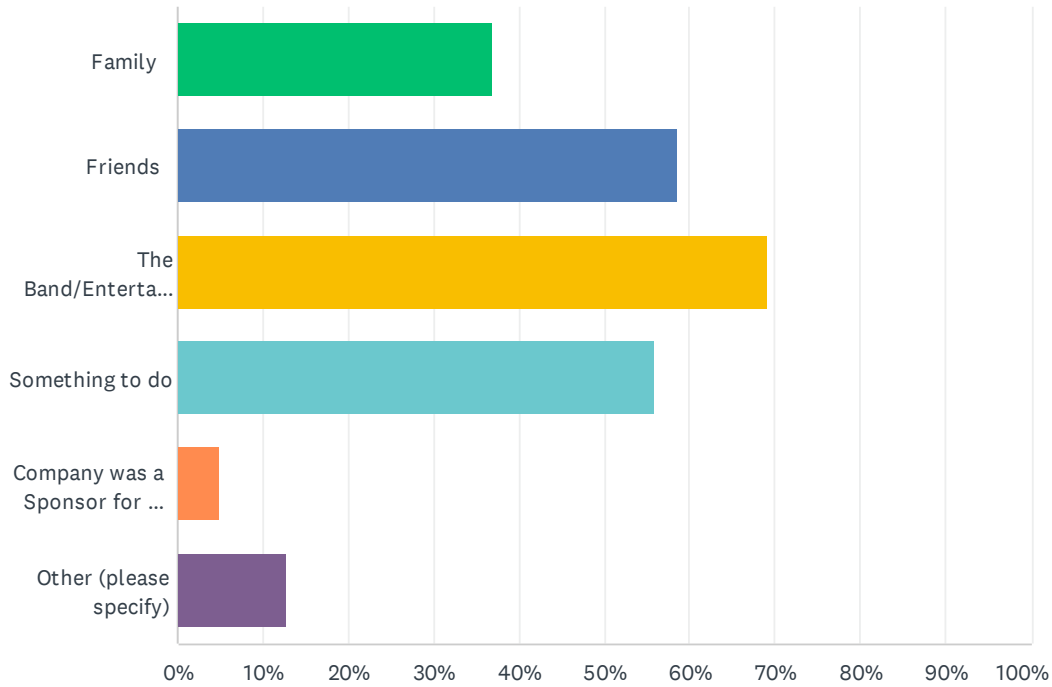

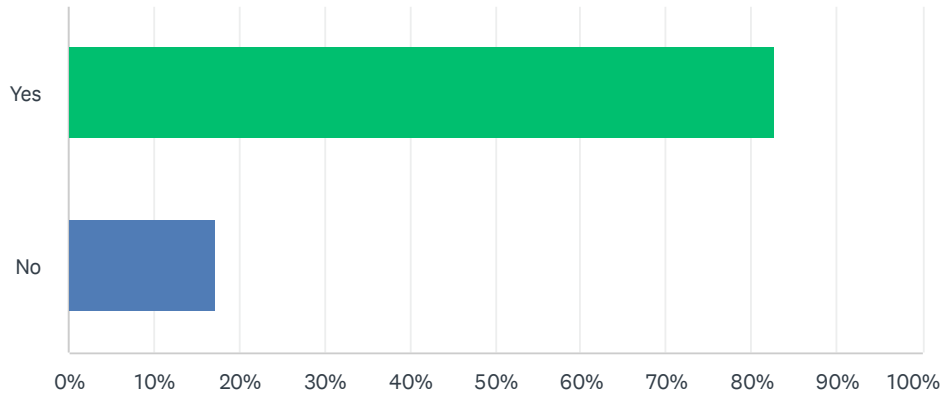
