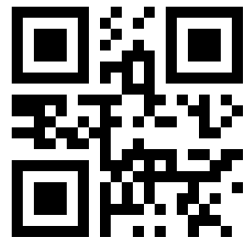

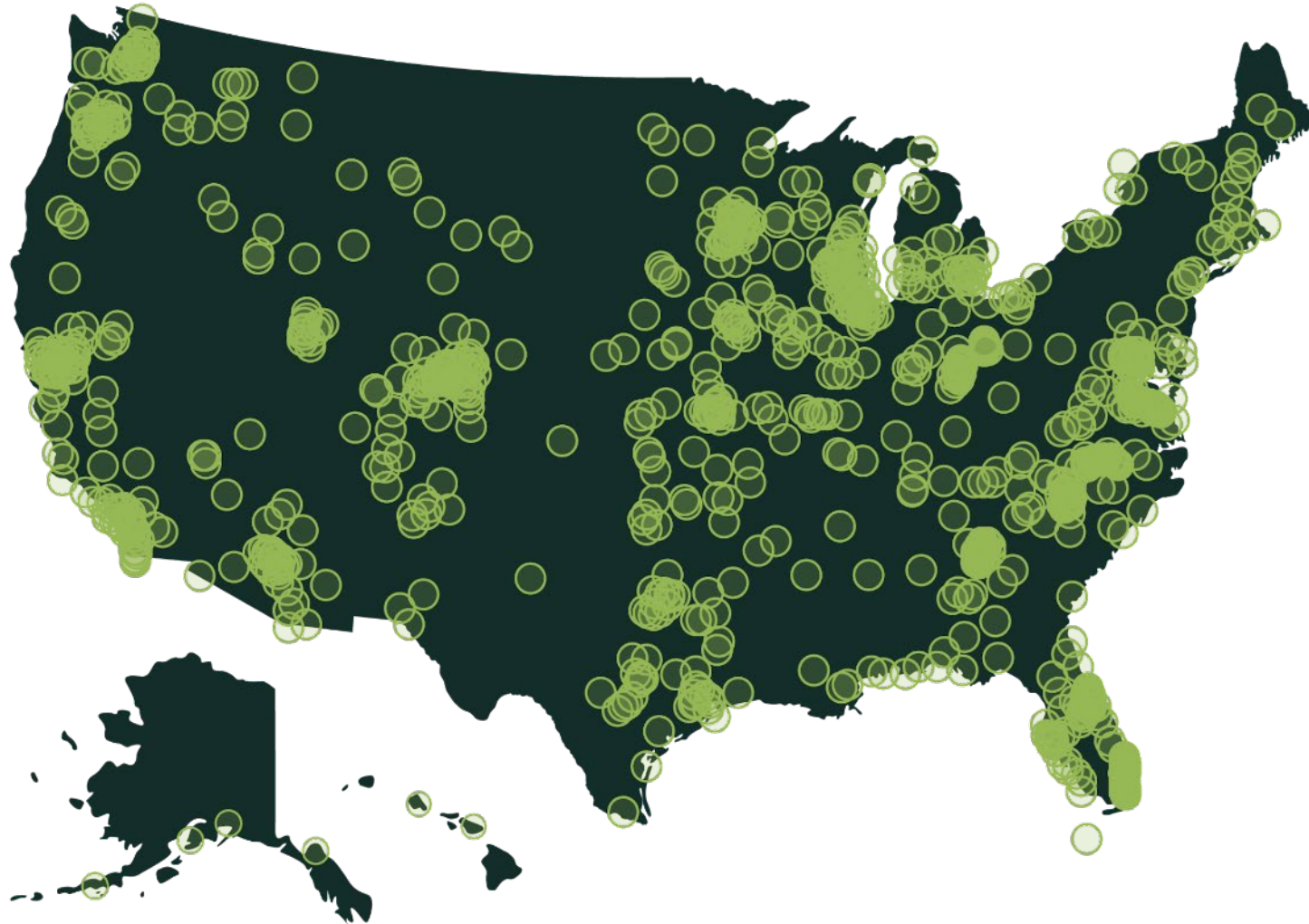

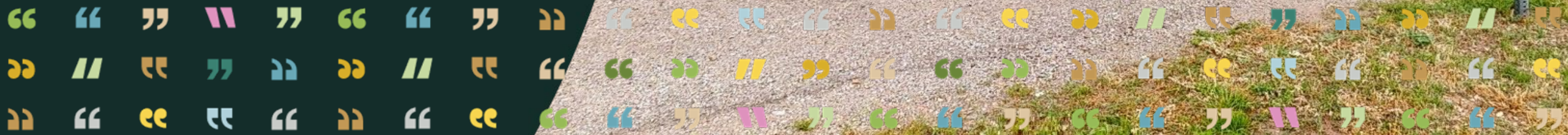


The NCS™ for Los Alamos County, NM

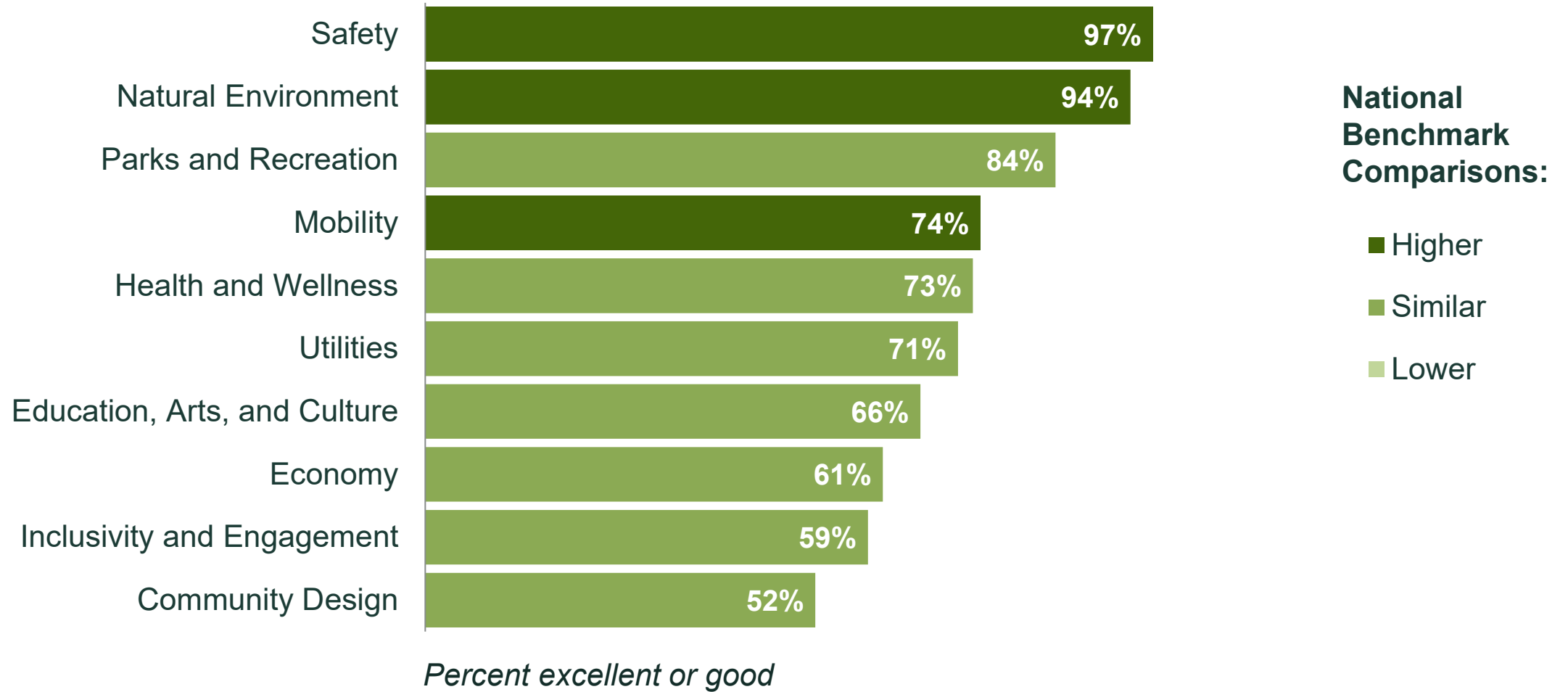
- 3rd time conducting The NCS (previous surveys in 2022 and 2020)
- Survey conducted from August 2, 2024 – September 6, 2024
- Mailing approach employed:
 - Probability-based sample of 3,500 randomly selected households
 - 419 total responses received
 - 12% overall response rate
 - Non-probability, open-participation survey: 217 responses
- Results statistically weighted to reflect Los Alamos County overall
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 5% margin of error



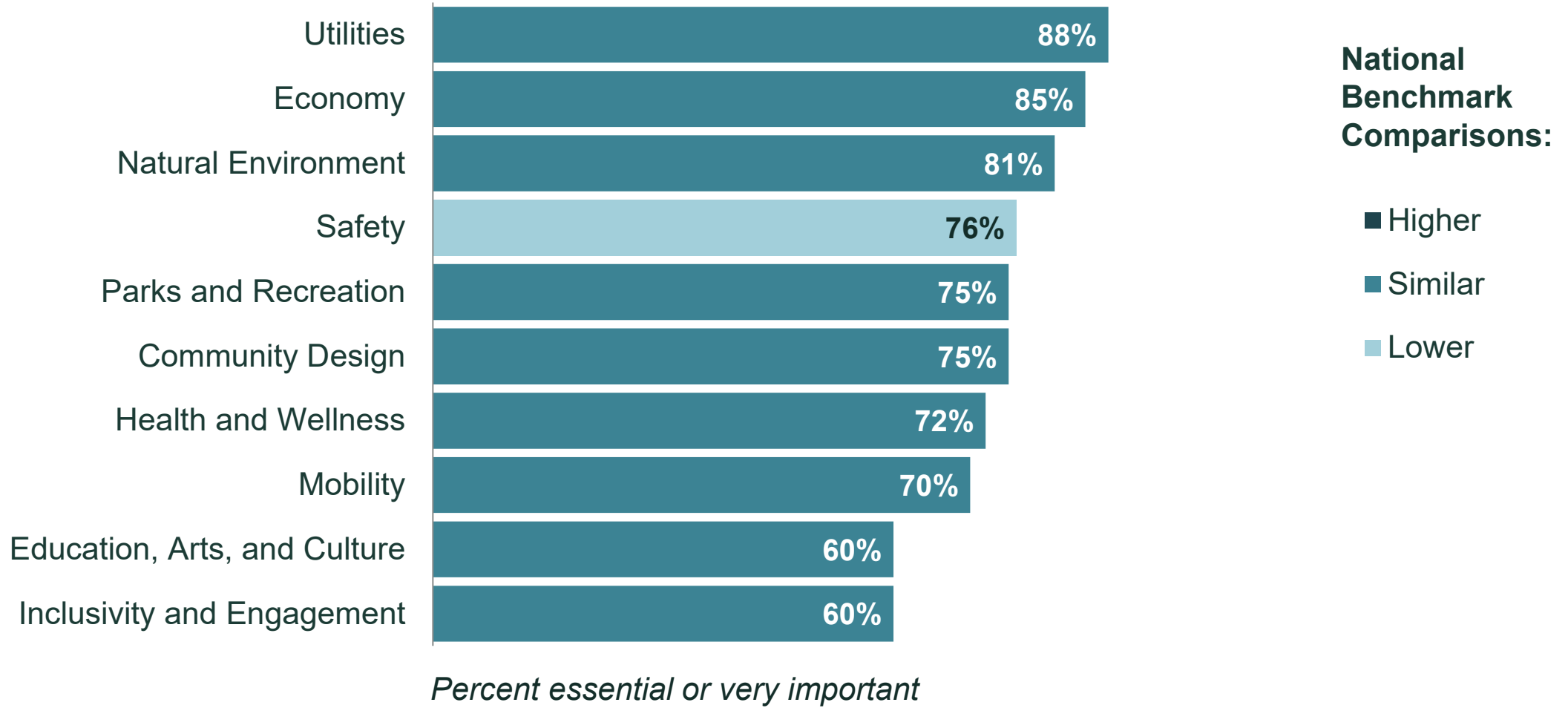

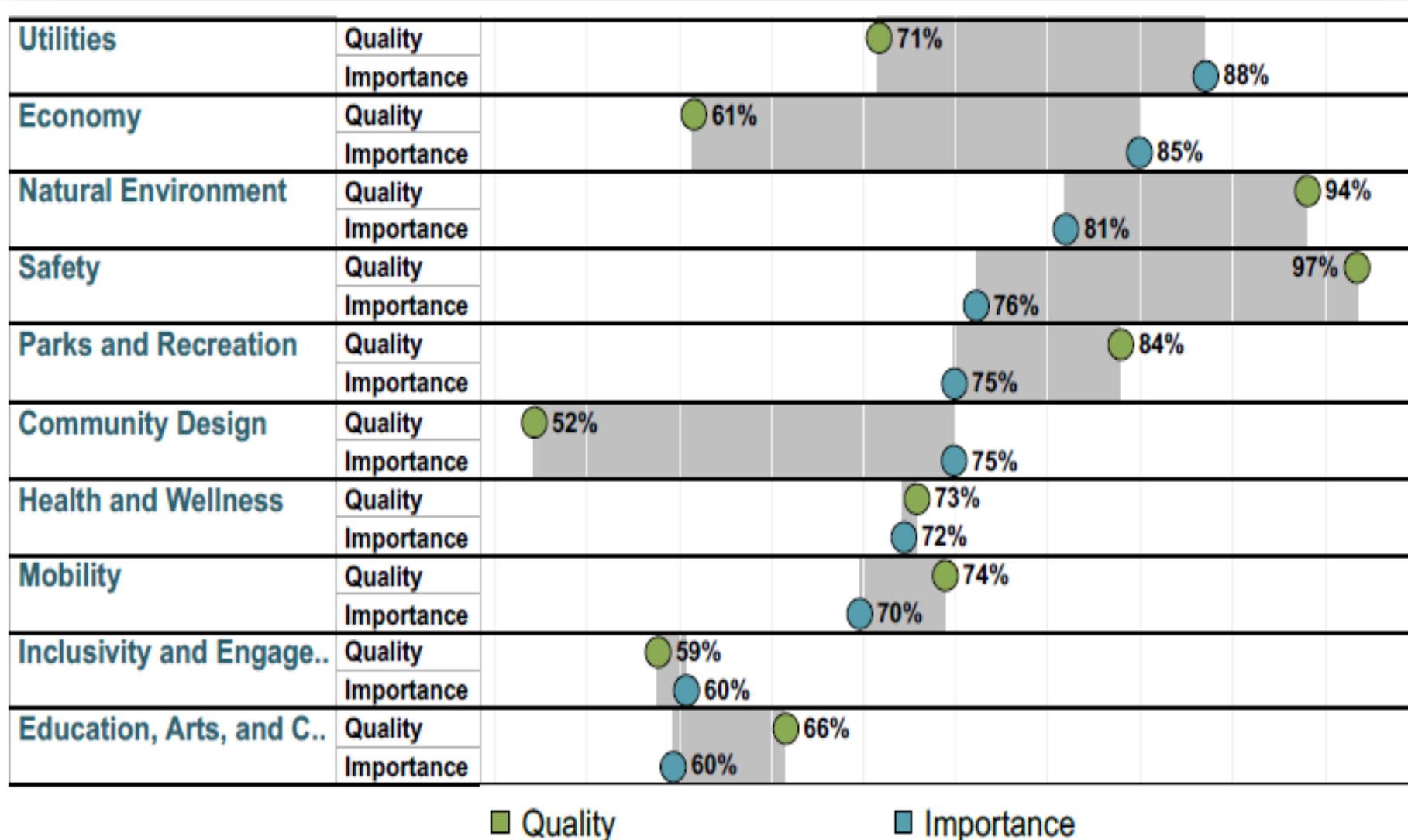
Facets of Community Livability: Quality

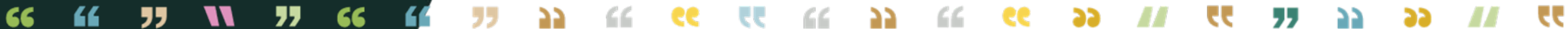

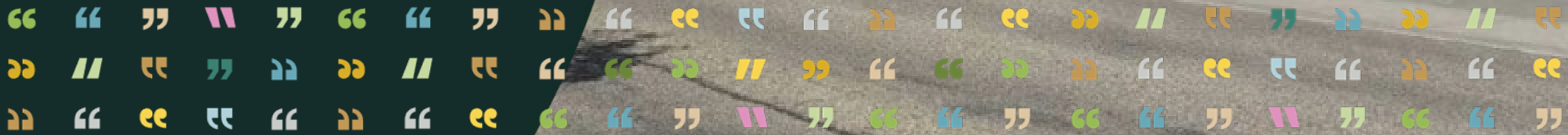

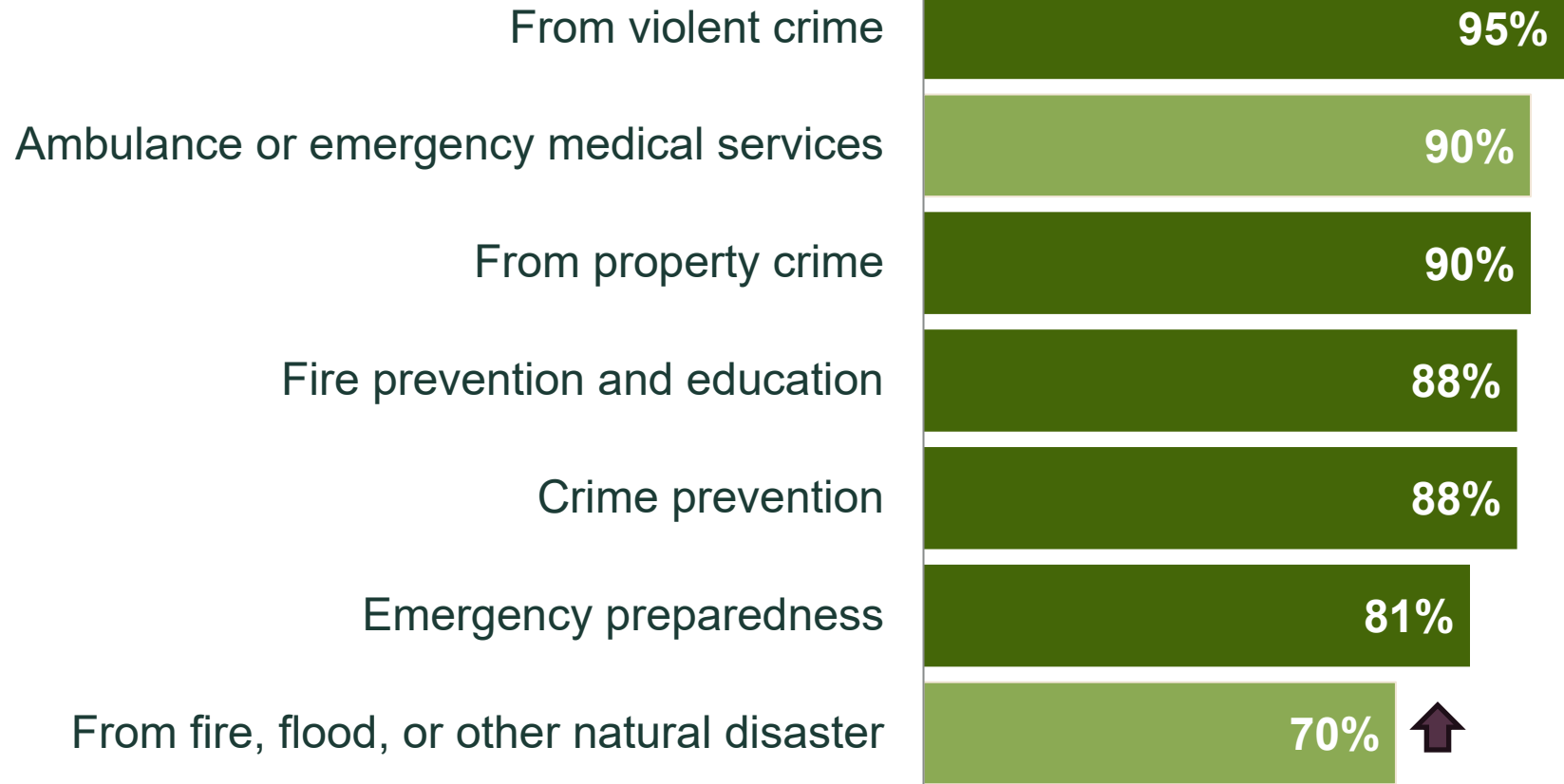

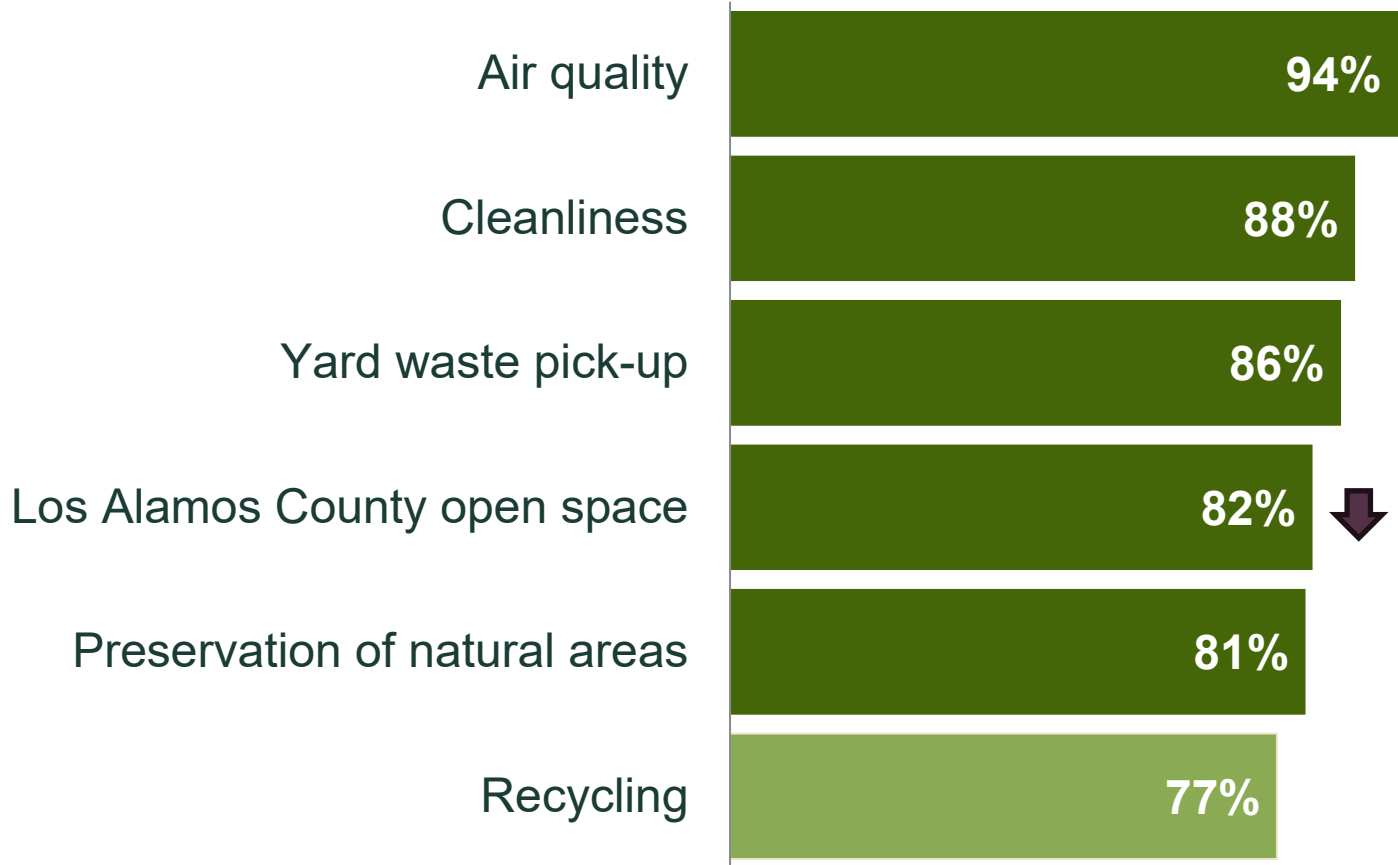
Natural Environment in Los Alamos County

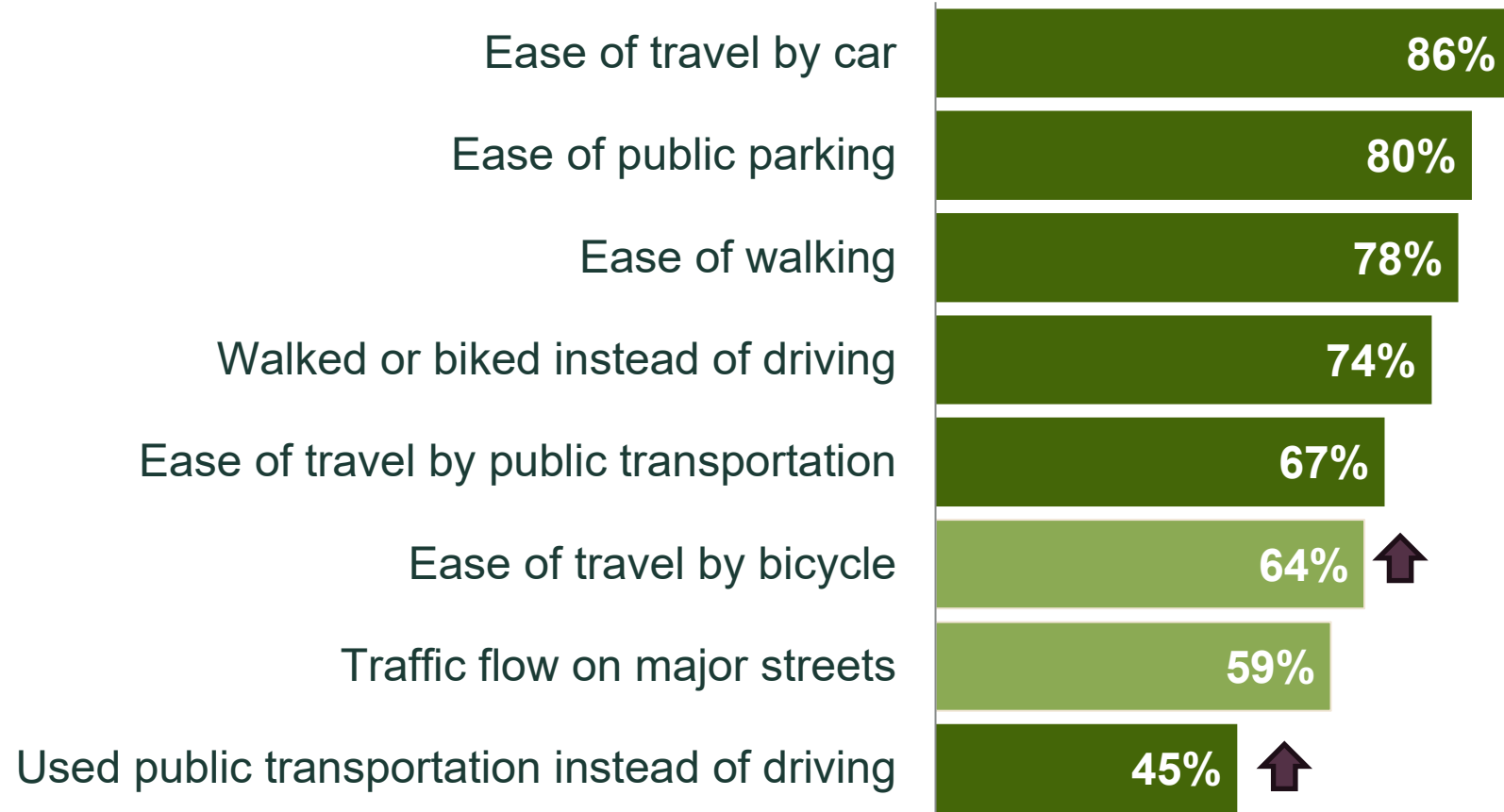

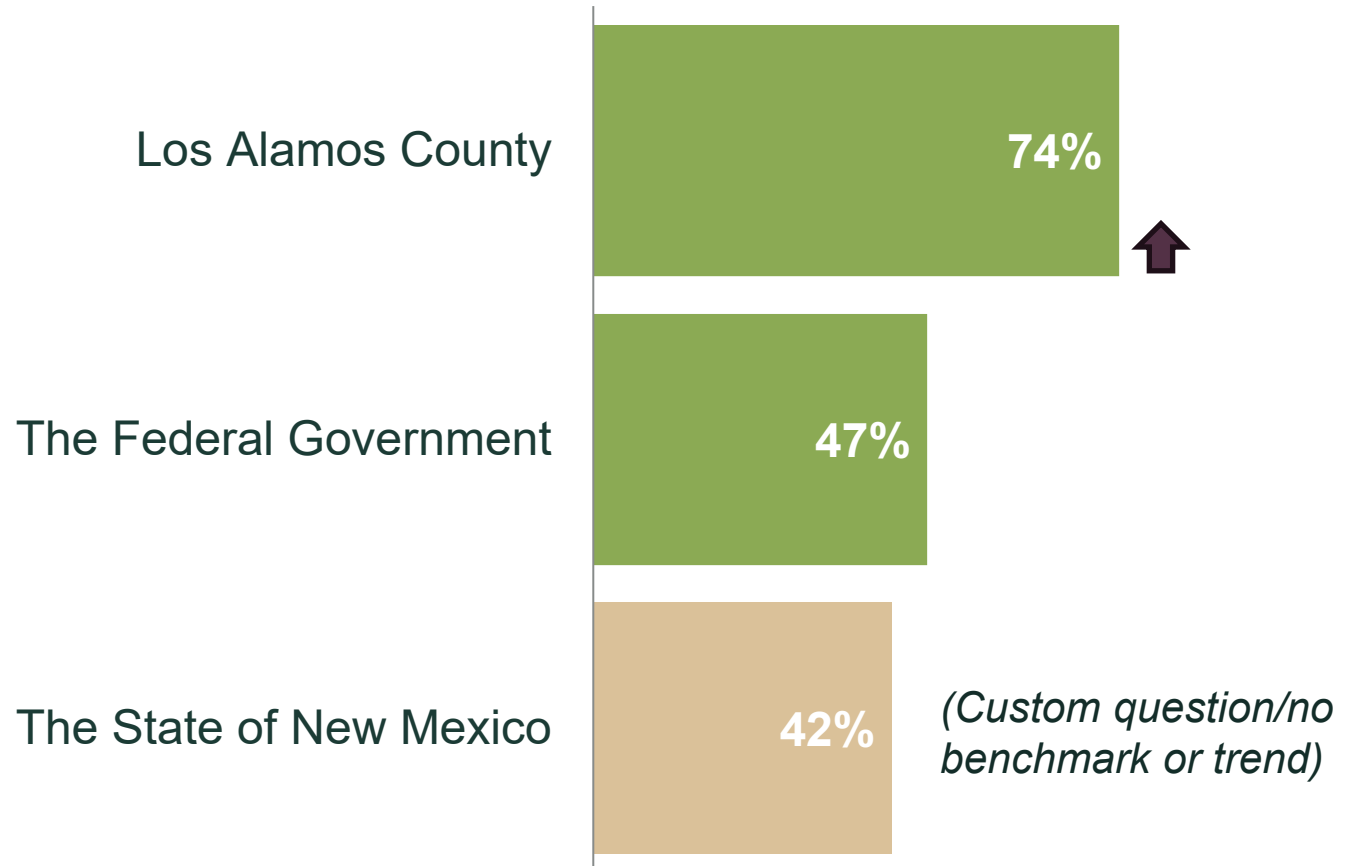

Economy in Los Alamos County

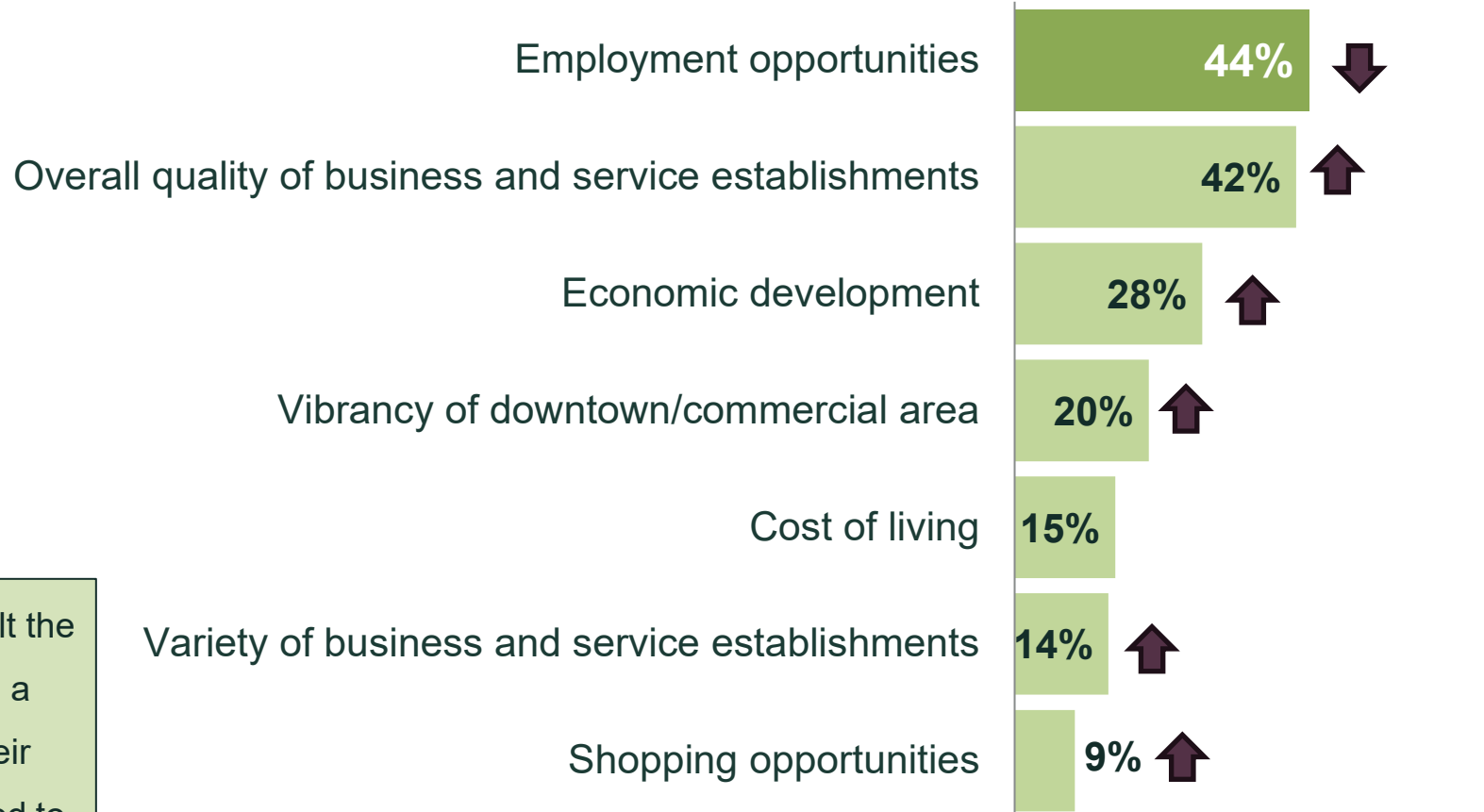

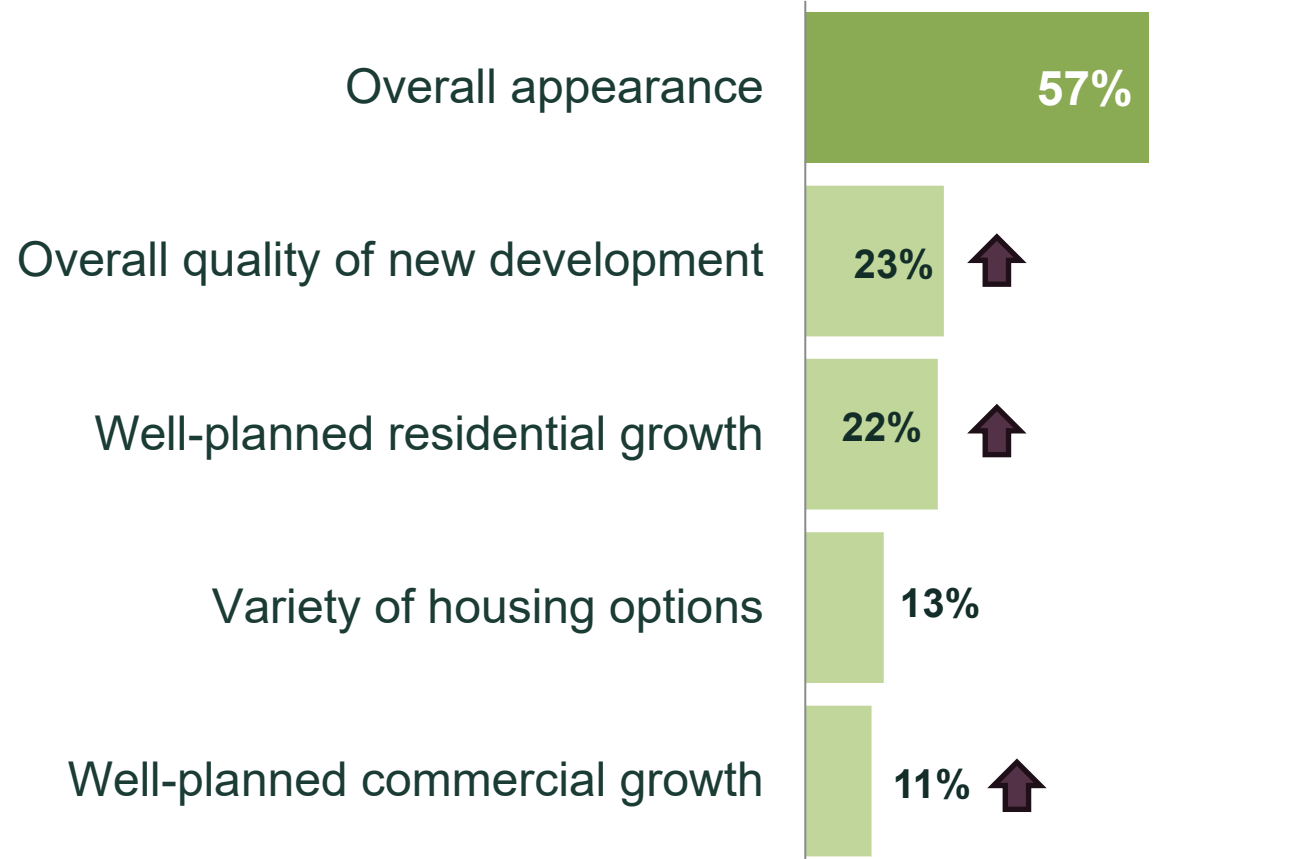

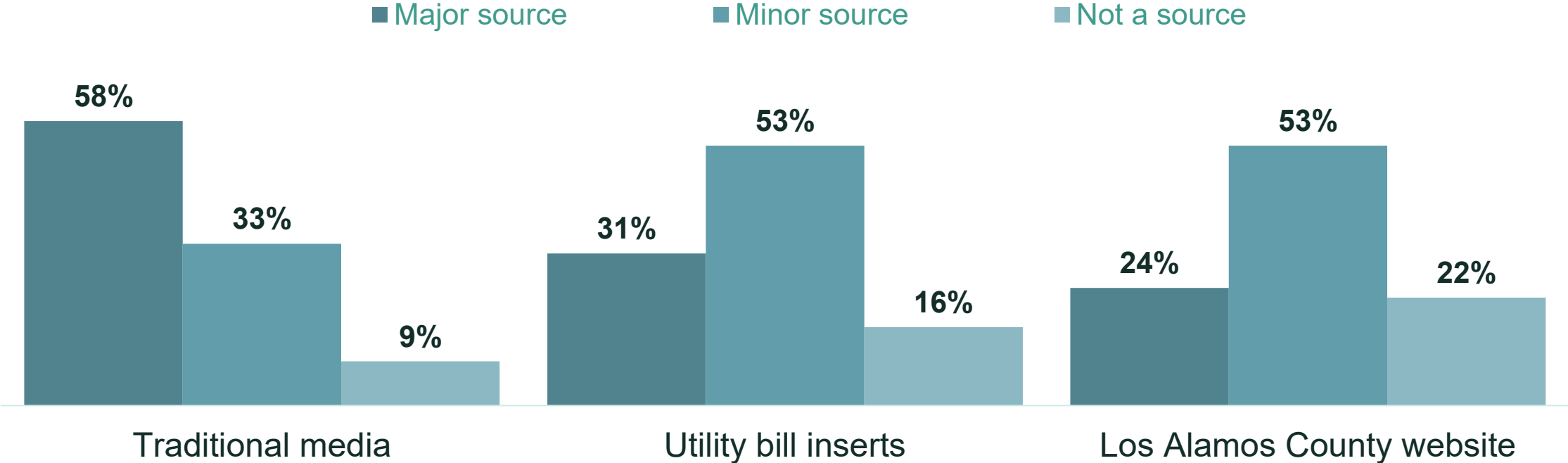

Summary of Conclusions

Highest-performing areas:

- Residents feel safe in Los Alamos County.
- Citizens value Los Alamos County's natural environment and recreational opportunities.
- Residents appreciate the County's arts, education, and culture, especially public library services.
- Local government was rated higher than the Federal Government.

Lowest-performing areas:

- Items related to the local economy and businesses remained lower than the national benchmark.
- Affordability stood out as a priority.
- Some ratings related to community design scored lower than the national benchmark
